- 1. Make sure that your name, age, mailing address, telephone number, e-mail address, the name of your school and the grade/year you are in are identified on your composition.
- Your composition should be no more than 500 words in length (2 pages, double-spaced).
 It should be either in digital format (word, rtf, pdf, ascii) or typed. Hand written compositions will not be accepted.
- 3. All compositions must be submitted no later than April 30, 2003
- 4. Schools or individual students may submit student essays

- 5. All compositions submitted must represent personal efforts.
- 6. It is recommended that all compositions be submitted in English, but those written in Finnish will also be accepted. (No other languages will be accepted.)
- 7. This writing competition is open to students in two age groups;
 - i) students aged 12 to 15 yrs.
 - ii) students aged 16 to 19 yrs.

- correct use of terminology
- an understanding of current technology
- inventive application of current technology to the future
- competent use of word processing with a minimum of errors
